**'Stay alert**

We can all help control the virus if we all stay alert. This means you must:

- stay at home as much as possible
- work from home if you can
- limit contact with other people
- keep your distance if you go out (2 metres apart where possible)
- wash your hands regularly

Do not leave home if you or anyone in your household has symptoms.'

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

 <b>How many people?</b>	Six from different households. Limit of 30 from two households	Up to eight from three households	Any number from two households	Up to 30 outdoors
 <b>At what distance?</b>	1m 'plus'	2m apart (less in some premises from 10 July)	2m apart	1m apart
 <b>Indoors</b>	Two households - limit of 30 people	Three households from 10 July	Two households can form one 'extended household' from 6 July	Up to six people
 <b>Outdoors</b>	Anywhere	Anywhere	Anywhere, from 6 July	Anywhere
